In the footsteps of Europe's Miners

Ancient mines, forgotten roads, abandoned railways and villages shaped by hard work still tell powerful stories. The European Mining Route reconnects these places through walking trails, living memories and experiences that blend nature, culture and identity.

Our mining routes



Cammino Minerario di Santa Barbara

📍 Italy

A 500 km trail across Sardinia's oldest mining landscapes. Walk from sea cliffs to mountain villages through 8.000 years of mining history and culture.



Barborská Cesta

📍 Slovakia

An educational 200 km loop through Slovakia's mining heartland. Connects medieval silver towns, UNESCO mining heritage, and Europe's first mining academy in a cultural trek.



GR412 Sentier des Terrils

📍 Belgium | 📍 France

A 300 km tribute trail across Wallonia's coalfields. Hike a chain of green slag heaps linking UNESCO-listed mines and industrial relics reborn as unexpected natural landmarks, soon to expand with connected French mining trails in a cross-border extension.



Aljustrel – Tem Uma Mina

📍 Portugal

A 12 km urban trail through Aljustrel's mining past. Wander from Roman-era mines to a reclaimed rural landscape and experience Alentejo's living mining heritage.



Idrija Miners Route

📍 Slovenia

A 33 km route through this UNESCO town, past shafts, smelters and miners' homes, revealing 500 years of mercury mining culture.



Caminos Mineros

📍 Spain

42 km of mining trails in the Comarca Andorra-Sierra de Arcos form an open-air museum of coal mining heritage. Explore restored mines and villages steeped in mining traditions.
